WEDDINGS AT THE RITZ

The Ritz London, one of the most magical and romantic locations for a wedding celebration, offers the perfect setting for a truly memorable occasion. The only hotel to have received a Royal Warrant for Banquet and Catering Services from His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales, The Ritz also holds a license for wedding ceremonies to be held in the hotel.

Reception, Banqueting and Private Dining Rooms

The Ritz provides a choice of spectacular private dining rooms which are suitable for either small, intimate family parties or larger more formal receptions.

William Kent House, the grand eighteenth century townhouse adjoining the hotel, is home to some of the most remarkable banqueting rooms in London. The most opulent of these beautifully restored dining rooms, the William Kent Room, has seating for up to 24 diners and features stunning original architecture dominated by a breathtaking coved ceiling in Italian Renaissance style. The adjacent Queen Elizabeth Room, an elegant drawing room overlooking Green Park, is ideal for wedding ceremonies and pre lunch or dinner cocktails for both the William Kent Room and the adjoining sixteen seat Wimborne Room.

The magnificent Music Room, the largest of the banqueting salons, can accommodate up to 60 guests for lunch or dinner and 120 guests for a reception. The Grand Hall, at the heart of William Kent House, is linked to all the rooms for further entertainment space and its elegant Victorian staircase, rising between two impressive marble pillars to the upper floors of the house, provides the perfect backdrop for bridal photography and wedding pictures.

Remarkably, for such an historic building, William Kent House has a degree of flexibility that allows it to cater for almost any event. Rooms can be used individually together or, for the ultimate event, the entire ground floor can be reserved.

In addition to the rooms in William Kent House, there is a further salon leading from the Long Gallery which can accommodate up to one hundred people for a cocktail reception. The Marie Antoinette Suite is said to be a replica of a salon in The Palace of Versailles, and with its classic elegance and mirrored interiors, it epitomises the grand and the graceful style of the hotel.

The Italian Garden, one of the few outdoor locations in central London, lies beyond the terrace of The Ritz Restaurant and is also licensed for wedding ceremonies. The prettily landscaped patio courtyard borders onto Green Park and during the warmer summer months can be used for wedding parties and cocktail receptions for up to one hundred people.

Wedding Services

Guest Rooms and Suites
